



iBlaze1394 Development Kit End User License Agreement (EULA)

This Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions for licensing the iBlaze1394 SKD and its supporting documentation, hereforth referred to as the Software, by you, hereforth referred to as the End User, from Alventix Technologies Inc., hereforth referred to as the Supplier. Installing and/or using the Software is an indication that the End User has read, understood and agreed with the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

The Supplier licenses but does not sell the Software to the End User. The Supplier is and will remain the sole proprietor of the Software while maintaining exclusive rights over it, including but not limited to the title and intellectual property contained in the Software. All rights not expressly granted in this Agreement are reserved by the Supplier.

Evaluation

If the End User has not yet purchased a license for the Software, the Supplier grants the End User a Demo License for an unlimited period of time. The End User has the right to freely distribute the demo version of the Software to third parties. The End User may not decompile, disassemble or reverse engineer the Software.

S1 License

This license permits a single developer to install and use the Software on a single machine. The End User may not redistribute the Software. The End User may not decompile, disassemble or reverse engineer the Software.

S2 License

This license permits multiple developers to install and use the Software on multiple machines. The End User may not redistribute the Software. The End User may not decompile, disassemble or reverse engineer the Software.

H1 License

This license permits multiple developers to install and use the Software on multiple machines. This license also permits the End User to redistribute compiled Supplier proprietary Software with a single hardware product. The End User may not decompile, disassemble or reverse engineer the Software.

H2 License

This license permits multiple developers to install and use the Software on multiple machines. This license also permits the End User to redistribute compiled Supplier proprietary Software with multiple hardware products. The End User may not decompile, disassemble or reverse engineer the Software.

F License

This license permits multiple developers to install and use the Software on multiple machines. This license also permits the End User to redistribute compiled Supplier proprietary Software with multiple hardware products, however the license does not permit redistribution of Supplier proprietary Software as source code either in whole or in part, modified or derived from Supplier's proprietary Software. The End User may use the source code of the Software to produce derived modules from it. The End User may only distribute built executables derived from the Software.

Warranty and Liability

The Software has been tested by the Supplier to have the properties described in the accompanying documentation. The Supplier does not provide warranty as pertaining to the suitability of the Software for the End User's specific use. Under no circumstances shall the Supplier be held liable for any direct or indirect damages, including but not limited to loss of data, loss of profit or business interruption, as a result of the End User using the Software.

Termination of Agreement

If the End User is found in breach of this Agreement, the Supplier may cancel the Agreement at any time with the direct result of the End User being unable to continue to use the Software either for commercial or non-commercial use. Upon cancellation of the Agreement the End User is required to destroy all electronic copies of the Software and/or return to the Supplier the provided Software.

Product Updates

The Supplier reserves the right to make changes to the Software in pursuit of progress. The Supplier may do so, without notice.

Should any portions of this Agreement be deemed invalid in any court, the remainder of the Agreement shall remain in full effect.

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the Province of Ontario, Canada.
